Two old vineyards dated 1914 Rowland Flat & 1932 Angaston Village. Naturally dry grown on an easterly aspect, among the fruit orchards and grain fields.

Treatment	Made via a mixture of whole berry and 25% whole bunch natural vineyard yeast ferment in small open top fermenters, soft pump overs, basket pressed into seasoned 500lt French oak barrels and bottled unfiltered.
Treatment	Very mild through spring and summer, with good top-up rainfall, a mild long dry summer has fruit of amazing flavours and natural holding acidity.
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
